As some of only a handful of invited guests each year, you will have your choice of accommodations in the "Museum Suite" (the owner's custom-designed victorian quarters), a medieval tower room perched directly over the Mediterranean, or the seafront terrace room in the adjacent Villa Margaurite with a kitchen and larger living space. Whichever you choose, you'll have access to the castle and Villa grounds, terraces, and rooftops, as well as a private art tour during your stay. When you're ready to explore outside the castle's walls, the small village of La Napoule boasts plentiful restaurants and bars, a small grocery store, and a selection of patisseries for your morning coffee. Just a block away is easy train service to Nice, Saint-Tropez, Marseille, and Monte Carlo. Cannes, home of the famed Film Festival, is only a five mile walk down the coast.
