Heronfield's teachers are dedicated to working with middle school students in this important period of academic, emotional and personal growth. As a small school, each person contributes to the community in many ways and also shares the joy of the work we do together.

Heronfield Academy seeks a bright and innovative teacher for the 2025-2026 school year who will join a vibrant and forward-thinking faculty and staff committed to provide the best possible experience for its students and families. The person in this full-time role will teach middle school mathematics, provide additional math support during and after the school day, and will collaborate with a longstanding teacher to ensure that the subject remains a hallmark for the school for years to come. The teacher in this role will also serve as an advisor in one of the school's three grades, and there will be additional opportunities to build connections with the school community through coaching and co-curricular activities.

At Heronfield, students progress from a general math course in sixth grade to pre-algebra in seventh grade, and then Algebra I in eighth grade. At each level, there is a strong emphasis on basic mathematics and study skills, and students are frequently encouraged to think creatively and collaborate in problem solving as a means of further learning. Teachers at Heronfield play a vital role in helping students develop the habits of mind and scholarship that will help them find success in the academic program, and there are opportunities to make a difference for students in the classroom and across the school day.

The ideal candidate will have:

- A commitment to the mission and core values of the school and to the growth of young people
- At least three years experience in teaching math at the middle or high school level
- A bachelor's in mathematics or a related field, with a master's degree an additional asset
- Experience working with middle school students and in guiding personal and academic growth
- Strong verbal and written communication skills, and demonstrated experience in using technology to enhance student learning
- Strong experience in developing and presenting innovative lessons and units, and an ability to meet the needs of a range of learners
- A willingness to both share ideas and learn from others to elevate the experience for all
- A proactive, positive, team-oriented approach to bringing all measures of success to the school
- A strong alliance with the school's commitment to community, equity and belonging
